ALICE, poverty, and combined hardship rates are population-weighted across each chapter's counties.

Definitions: ALICE means Asset Limited, Income Constrained, Employed. Combined hardship is the source field for households/people below ALICE or poverty thresholds. People counts are estimated by applying county percentages to county population and summing by chapter. Expected Annual Loss (EAL) comes from FEMA National Risk Index-derived county data.
